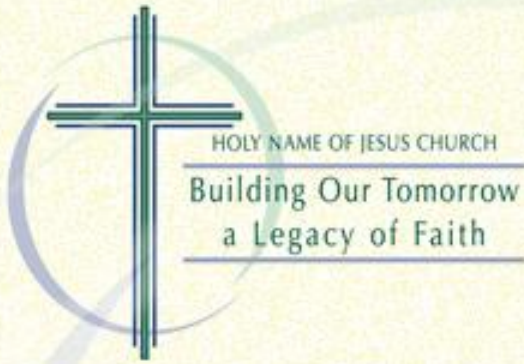
# The Need for a New Church

- **Aging facilities – originally constructed in 1960**
- **3,400 member families, 9,000 parishioners and growing**
- **8 weekend Masses**
- **Deferred maintenance**
- **Outdated security and energy technology**
- **Set stage for future school improvements and elimination of the modulars**



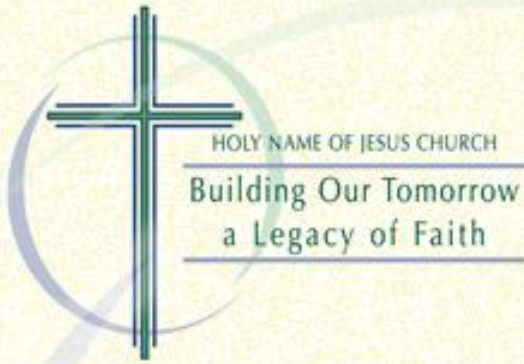
# Brief History of the Project

- **March, 2003 – Walmart opportunity**
- **May, 2006 – THF/Walmart offer withdrawn**
- **Legal dispute over \$750,000 continues**
- **2007 Capital Campaign**
- **May, 2007 - Kickoff meeting**
- **October, 2007 parish wide fundraising begins**
- **Campaign goal set at \$5 million**
- **New church construction estimated at \$7.25 million**



# Accomplishments

- **New roof on church and school**
- **School church connector building**
- **Upgraded sound system**
- **Covered ceiling in gym**
- **New doors on the front of the building**
- **Over \$4.5 million in Faith Promises and other donations**
- **Over \$3.4 million in savings and interest**
- **Selected architect and site engineer**
- **Lower estimates for construction**
- **Bishop and Diocese approval to move forward**



# Capital Campaign Status

- **Third year of the campaign**
- **\$5 million goal**
- **Over \$3.6 million raised so far**
  - **Fulfilled pledges, other donations, interest on savings**
- **Need to collect outstanding pledges and additional donations to reach goal**

Good circulation with multiple access points



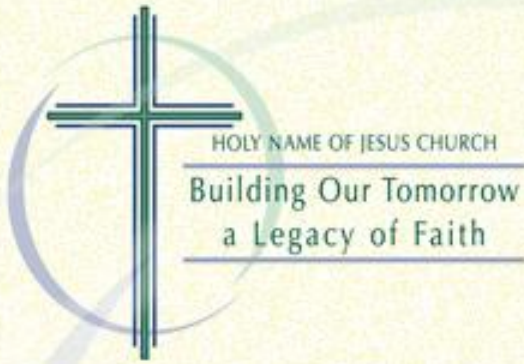

Includes 500 parking spaces

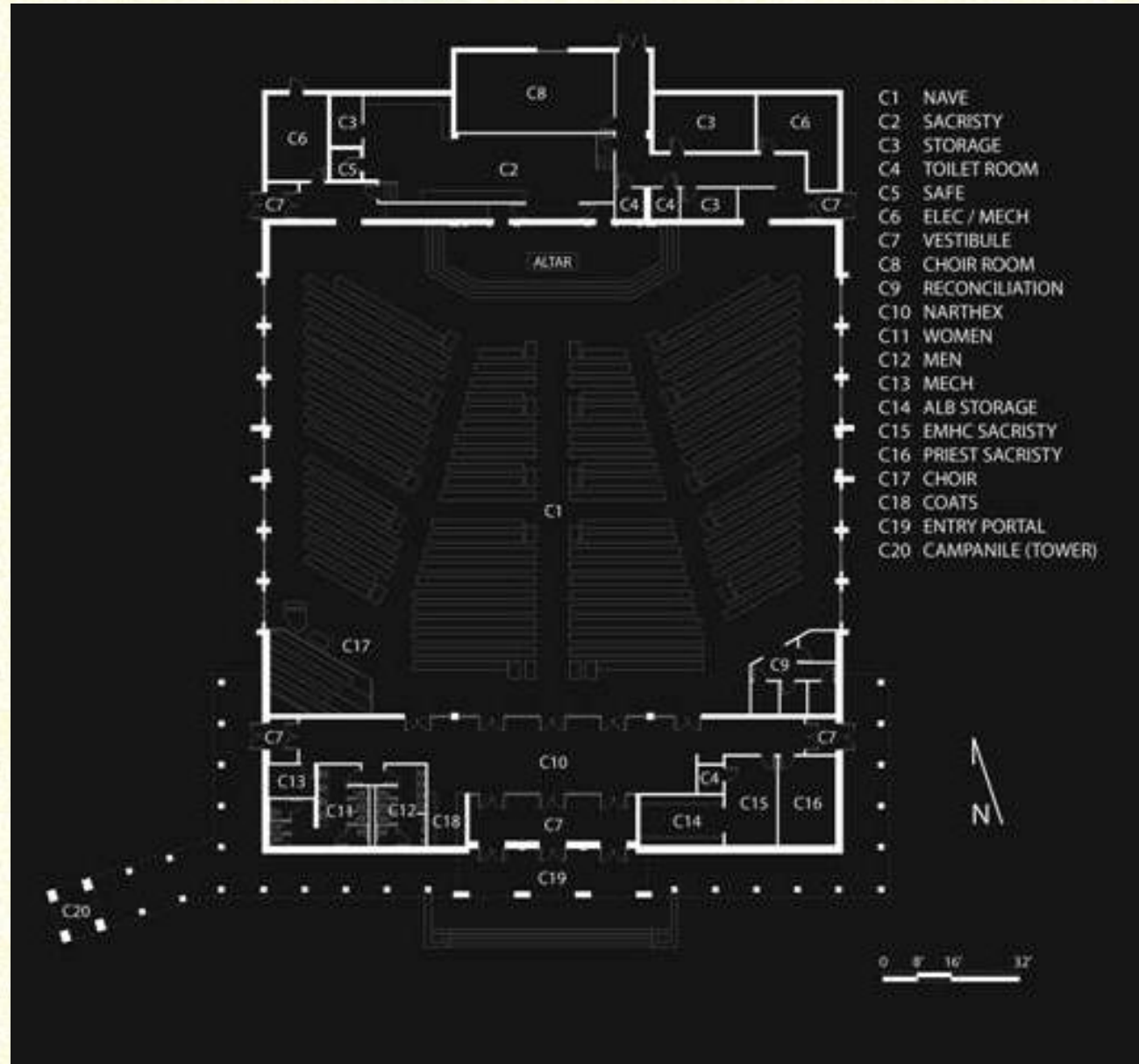
Diocese and township review still required

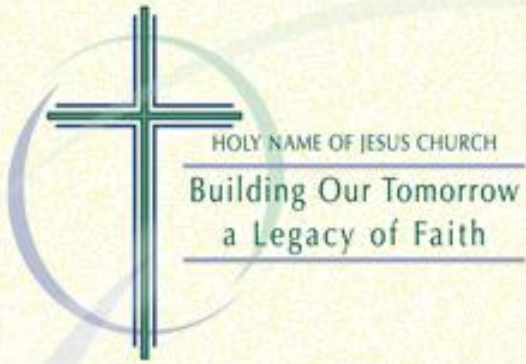




# Church Floor Plan

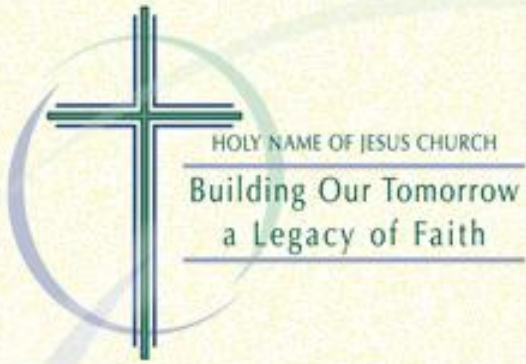

Rt. 81 and Rt. 22**

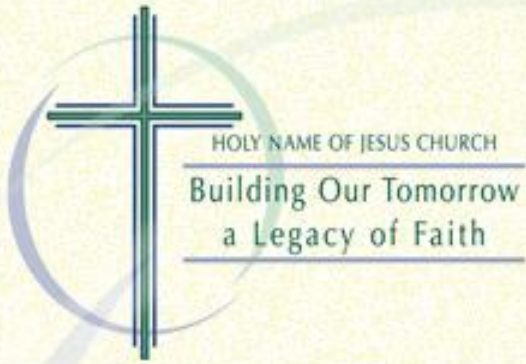




# Approach View / Entry Facade

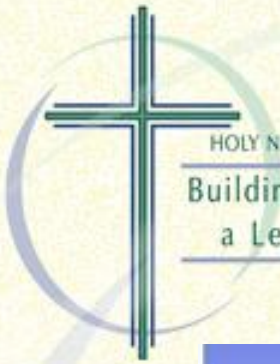

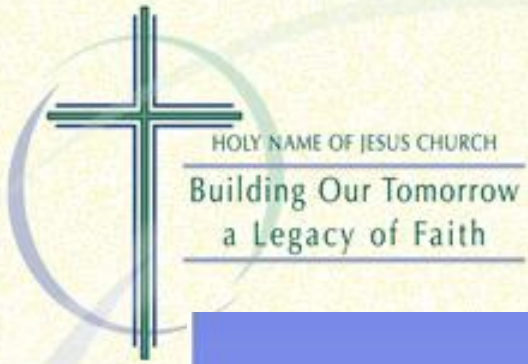

arched doors

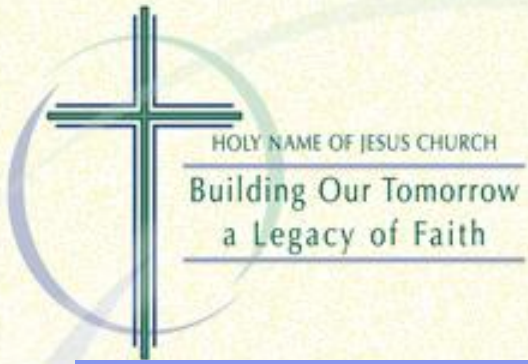

Portal window potentially with stained glass





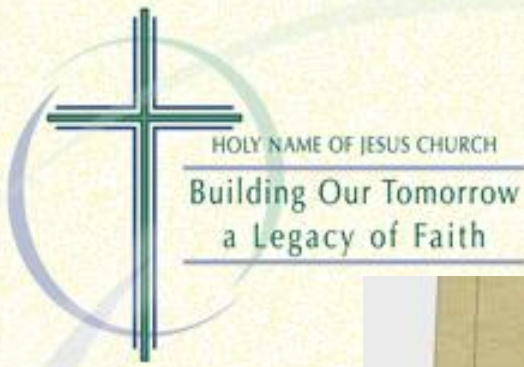

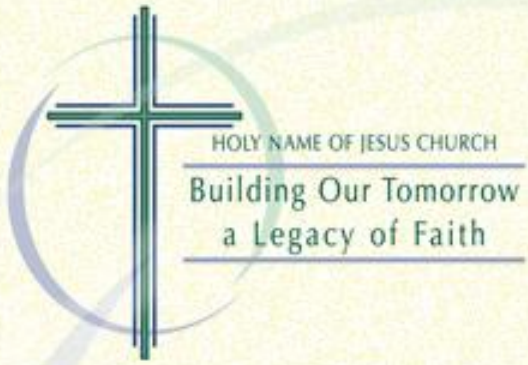
Patterns of brick and stone work together
