Classroom Spotlight Grade 5

The 5th grade is keeping very busy this year! Now that the month of January has begun, we are anxious to start our Science Fair projects. We will be gathering facts and conducting experiments in the classrooms soon. Once we compile all our facts and the results of our experiments we will create display boards. The finished projects will be presented on Math and Science Night, April 19, 2012.

Our field trip to Gettysburg is in April. We'll have the opportunity to walk in the footsteps of the actual soldiers who fought in Pickett's Charge and see some other historical sites.

We are also looking forward to the last two Fridays in March when we will have the opportunity to lead the Stations of the Cross for grades 5-8 for the very first time. It's an exciting year that's going by too fast, but it is sure to be a memorable one.



Computer Highlights

Our students in first grade are learning to type. They are now typing spelling words in color. Students in second and third grade are correcting typing errors in documents such as spelling, font types, and tab. The fourth through sixth grade are learning to make tables and graphs. The seventh and eighth grade are creating PowerPoint presentations using audio editing software and embedding video.

For several years the computer program has included a technology club for 7th and 8th grade students. The technology club members or "Techies" come to the Computer Lab to learn about installing computer hardware and software. These students come to the Computer Lab during their lunch recess time.

Student Registrations For Kindergarten and Pre-School

Holy Name of Jesus School will be accepting **NEW REGISTRATIONS** for kindergarten and pre-school for the 2012-2013 school year during Catholic Schools Week.

The Registration Schedule is:

Monday, January 30 and Tuesday, January 31 —
9:00am until 2:00pm and 4:00pm to 6:00pm

Wednesday, February 1 and Thursday, February 2—
9:00am until 2:00pm

Requirements for New Registrations:

- New Kindergarten students **must be age 5 by August 31, 2012 .**
- New Pre-school students **must be age 3 or 4 and potty trained by August 31, 2012**
- Must have the following documents for **all grades being registered at time of registration:**
 - ♦ *Birth Certificate*
 - ♦ *Baptismal Certificate*
 - ♦ *Copy of Immunizations*
 - ♦ *Any necessary legal documents*

Registrations cannot be accepted without the above documents.



Scholarship and Financial Aid Information

You will have two opportunities to pursue financial aid for the 2012-2013 school year: The Neumann Scholarship and the Student Aid Form through the South Central PA Educational Improvement Program, Inc.

Information on Neumann Scholarship Foundation

Should I apply for a scholarship?
 Scholarships are available:

1. to Pennsylvania residents only
2. if your child/ren attend a Catholic school
3. if your household income falls below the state guidelines for maximum income

Income Eligibility Guidelines:

1. Parents/Guardians maximum combined income: \$60,000.00
2. Income limit increases \$12,000.00 for each additional member of the household.
3. If any other member of the household files a Pennsylvania tax form, that income must be included in your calculation of household income. For example: parents combined earnings are \$65,000.00. There are two dependent children in the household. One is a high school student with a part time job, who earned \$5,000.00. Household income is actually \$70,000.00. However, the family's income limit for eligibility is \$84,000.00 (\$60,000.00 + \$12,000.00 for each child). The family would meet the state eligibility guideline for a scholarship.

May I apply for more than one EITC scholarship?

1. Yes.
2. There may be more than one organization offering partial scholarships in your area.
3. The total amount of scholarship assistance you receive through the EITC program may not exceed the published tuition.

Important Reminders:

1. If you determine that you may be eligible for a scholarship, applications are available at the

school office at 657-1704. The application for **The Neumann Scholarship** application can also be found on the Diocesan website www.hbgdiocese.org using the **Catholic Schools** link or <http://www.hbgdiocese.org/Admin/Uploads/Catholic%20Schools/Documents/2011%20Form%20429%20HRBG%20INTs.pdf>. Do not "save" this form on this site, please download, print, and once it is filled out submit it to the school office.

2. **One application is used per family**, even if students attend different Catholic schools in the diocese.
3. Please fill in all forms carefully and attach the required documents. Both Federal and State tax forms will be required.

All forms and documentation are due to our school office by March 9, 2012.

Holy Name will pay the application fee.

School Delays for Emergency/Weather and Early/Emergency Dismissal Information

With all that is going on in the world, we need to make sure we are always prepared and have planned ahead. At Holy Name of Jesus School we always try to be prepared and plan ahead.

In the beginning of every school year we send all of our families Emergency Dismissal Forms. This is a three-part-form. It is important that we have one form per student. This form helps us to know exactly how you want your child(ren) dismissed in the event of an Early/Emergency Dismissal. Please review with your child(ren) your copy of the information you retained for your records so that they know what you have instructed us to do. **Make sure your child(ren) know if they are to:**

- ride the bus
- be a car rider and with whom
- where to go.

Holy Name of Jesus School does not provide our own bussing. The delay/dismissal decisions come from the school districts that provide your child's bussing.

Please be aware that some of the school districts dismiss earlier than others. We do have many school districts that provide bussing for us; make sure you check the delay/dismissal information for your school district as well as what Holy Name is doing.

In the case of an Early/Emergency Dismissal or School Delay do not call the school; we must keep our phone lines clear. All of the school districts that provide bussing for our students must be able to contact us during delays and dismissals. Messages will be sent via the Mass Communication System. Coke Rewards - We have 1,844 points. Don't forget to enter them online and designate them to Holy Name of Jesus School.

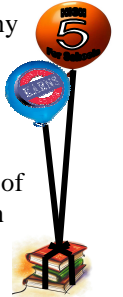
