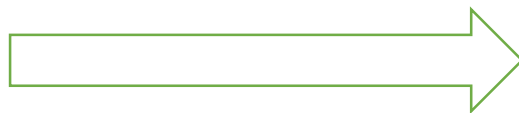
### **Tuesday, October 26, 2021 – “Don’t Fall to the Power, Rise Up Like a Flower; Drug Free Looks Like Me”!**
