Those students who choose to do Science Fair as an eighth grade student will be graded on their Science Fair Project. They will receive an extra grade for that trimester. In addition, students will receive extra credit according to a rubric that will be distributed the first week of school in Science class. Our goal is that each student will devote all their time and effort into developing quality projects. The students are encouraged to accept the challenge of completing both assignments. One of the purposes of these projects is to prepare the students for their high school experience.

Since Science Fair and National History require a great deal of instruction and guidance, all seventh grade students will be required to do both the National History and the Science Fair project.

Therefore, any eighth grade student who chooses to do Science Fair and all seventh grade students must come prepared on the first day of school with his or her topic.
