We have posted on the school website information about the Coronavirus that we have received from the Pennsylvania Department of Health.

Currently, the Department of Health has not recommended that Holy Name of Jesus School implement any special measures beyond the usual suggestions to prevent the spread of the virus.

Students are reminded to wash their hands with warm, soapy water frequently throughout the school day and to use hand sanitizer. Clorax wipes are used on the desk tops to hinder the spread of germs. The school and bathrooms are cleaned each evening.

Any student who is feeling ill should stay home. Students are to be fever free without medication for twenty-four hours before returning to school. If there are concerns about academic success because of a student missing a number of days for illness, we will work with the student.
